
### CHANUTE EARLY LEARNING CENTER

- Student Headcount: 146
  - 71 3-year-olds
  - 75 4-year-olds
- Maximum Classroom Capacity: 18
- Pupil-Teacher Ratio: 6:1
- At-Risk (Free Lunch): 55%
  - Currently our district has received a grant that allows all preschoolers to eat breakfast and lunch for free




### CHANUTE EARLY LEARNING CENTER

- Students with an IEP: 17%
  - Receive several Birth to 3 referrals for evaluation
  - screens 3- and 4-year-olds almost monthly throughout the year




# STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION OUTCOMES

- Social/Emotional
  - Measured by the Gold Assessment
  - Creative Curriculum provides social-emotional support with the additional curriculum/ manipulatives (Al's Pals)
- Students are determined ready for Kindergarten by the Gold Assessment and Pre-K Standards.




# CURRICULUM NEEDS

    - Area of need to create a systematic approach for data collection, analysis, and reporting.




# STAFF NEEDS

    - increase enrollment opportunities at CELC




# STAFF NEEDS

- 25-26 School Year
  - 2 full day Pre-K Classrooms
    - Additional teacher hired
  - 4 half day 3-year-old classrooms and 4 half day 4 year old classrooms.
  - Currently, all certified positions filled.
  - Still need to fill paraeducator positions




# STAFF NEEDS

- Professional Development
  - Early Childhood LETRS:
    - 5 teachers trained during the 24-25 school year
    - Continued training for new certified staff
    - Implementation in the classroom
  - PBIS
