### **CEMS AK STAR State Assessments Update**

- Alaska's Department of Education and Early Development (DEED) has partnered with NWEA to implement a creative approach to balanced statewide assessment that better reflects learning throughout the school year and helps educators target instruction to students' individual needs. The Alaska System of Academic Readiness (AK STAR) is designed to streamline the testing experience for grades 3–9 in the areas of English language arts (ELA) and mathematics. This balanced approach connects fall and winter MAP Growth interim assessments and the Alaska spring summative assessment to provide a comprehensive assessment system that improves efficiency and cohesion and drives student outcomes by prioritizing teaching and learning.
- The AK STAR Window will open on Monday, March 28, 2022. As that is the Monday immediately following CCSD's Spring Break, the CEMS will be looking at the week of April 4<sup>th</sup> and April 11<sup>th</sup> for AK STAR Testing in the elementary & middle school.
- Please make note that students in Grades 3-8 will be administered the computer-based version of the AK STAR in English/Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics (MA). Students in grades 5 & 8 will also be tested on Science (SCI).
- Tentatively, Grades 3-5 in the elementary school are to be scheduled to test on Tuesday, April 5<sup>th</sup> (ELA), Wednesday, April 6<sup>th</sup> (MA), and Thursday, April 7<sup>th</sup> (SCI/5<sup>th</sup> only). Grades 6-8 in the middle school are to be scheduled to test the following week on Tuesday, April 12<sup>th</sup> (ELA), Wednesday, April 13<sup>th</sup> (MA), and Thursday, April 14<sup>th</sup> (SCI/8<sup>th</sup> only).
- Testing will begin at approximately 8:25 AM in the elementary and middle school. The estimated total testing time for each individual assessment varies and can be anywhere from 150-180 minutes; however, the tests are not timed, so students may take as long as they need up to one school day.
