## 28E Contract with NIACC for Concurrent Enrollment Classes

## **Background:**

Back in the mid-1980's, Harlan Community School District was the first high school in Iowa to begin offering college credit classes as part of the regular high school curriculum. Today, numerous districts across the state are offering college credit classes.

For many years now, Belmond-Klemme CSD has held a 28E sharing agreement with North Iowa Area Community College (NIACC) in order to offer college credit courses to the students of Belmond-Klemme through their Concurrent Enrollment program. The cost to the Belmond-Klemme district is mostly covered by the additional weighting dollars that Belmond-Klemme receives from the state for the shared program.

At the end of this page is a list of classes that students from Belmond-Klemme High School may take. In addition, students may take vocational classes at on campus at NIACC and at the Rockwell Academy.

## **Recommended Action:**

Renewal of the 28E contract with NIACC will continue the sharing agreement which will allow our students to access the classes listed below. I recommend renewal of the 28E contract with North Iowa Area Community College.
