SPARK Program Report- 2016 Board of Education Meeting - August 17th, 2016

This year our SPARK (Students Practicing Applications of Real-world Knowledge) courses were held at Westview (various course from June 13th- August 5th). We offered courses for students in District 7, along with surrounding districts, in kindergarten - 7th grade. Transportation was not offered by the school district. Student cost was \$75 per course (in-district) and \$100 per course (out of district).
