 - i. Priority= Phonological Awareness (7% above benchmark)
- b. 1st grade= 25% CORE, 11% Strategic, 64% Intensive
 - i. Priority= Phonemic Awareness (18% above benchmark)
- c. 2nd grade= 44% CORE, 6% Strategic, 49% Intensive
 - i. Priority= Phonics (33% CLS-above benchmark)
- d. 3rd grade= 46% CORE, 11% Strategic, 43% Intensive
 - i. Priority= Phonics (23% accuracy- above benchmark)

1) 21st Century Grant update in our 2nd year of 5 year funding

- In year 2 of 5 year funding for 4 schools in district (EV, NVHS, HVHS, and LBMS)
- Support after school classes and summer school with community partners
- Missy Morgan is our Site Coordinator
- Classes began on 9/23/19 (B and G classes) with others adding-on in October (Monday-Thursday 2-5:30pm)
 - Everstars (2 classes), Twinkle Stars, SMILE, Boys and Girls Club (Power hour- academic support for kids), LegoLand, Art Extravaganza, Books Art Fun, Ed Games (computers), Food for Fall, Learning of Music, and another Art Class will be offered this first round of classes in the Fall 2019
 - Class applications have been made and given to staff at Evergreen
 - Classes need to be at least 4 weeks long
 - Per our grant we need to have 125 students participating in over 30 days/classes
 - Academic/STEAM focused
