## Pediculosis (Head Lice)

(A student with nits and/or infested with live lice will be allowed to remain in school.)

A student with a suspected case of head lice may be referred to designated trained staff for a screening. The screening will be done in a confidential manner by trained personnel.

School personnel will notify the parent or guardian of a student found with head lice and <u>may</u> provide information on <del>appropriate</del> treatment. The student will be allowed to remain in school.

The Suggested school measures for head lice control, as provided in Communicable Disease Guidance for Schools

Head Lice Guidance published issued by the Oregon Department of Education and the Oregon Health Authority,

Public Health Division will be consulted considered.
