**Re:** Bid #1192 – District-wide Refuse Removal and Recycling Services

This bid was advertised according to statute and bid documents were sent to three contractors. Two bids were received in response to the School District's request for bids for District-wide Refuse Removal and Recycling Services for the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. Waste Management, 3101 West Superior Street, Duluth, MN submitted the low combined bid for an annual amount based on site specific criteria as identified in bid attachments in the amount of \$73,156.00.

It is recommended the Duluth School Board approve the contract with Waste Management to provide refuse removal and recycling services, based on their low bid submitted pursuant to Bid #1192 – District-wide Refuse Removal and Recycling Services.

It is further recommended the Duluth School Board approve the two (2) additional contract extension options through June 30, 2013, if the amount is determined acceptable by the Director of Business Services and the Property and Risk Manager.
