Background Information:

- The Keller Independent School District must approve a Call of Election as per the attached information.

Administrative Considerations:

- Candidate filing began February 11, 2008 and will end March 10, 2008 at 5:00 PM for the general election for Places 4 and 5.
- Election Day is Saturday, May 10, 2008.
- The Election must be canvassed between Tuesday, May 13, 2008 and Wednesday, May 21, 2008. To assure that any provisional ballots have been processed and to receive mail ballots sent from outside the United States, canvassing should be scheduled for Friday, May 16 – Wednesday, May 21.
- A run-off Election, if applicable, must be ordered at the same meeting in which the May 10 Election is canvassed. As a result, a full quorum of the board will be required.

The administration recommends that the Board of School Trustees hereby give Notice of an Election as per the attached Motion and Call of Election.
