Chad Hanson is getting us volunteers from local churches; we got

several Aspire volunteers this past week. They are being trained and will meet with students one time a week and help with their plans after high school.

Ryan Clark will be transferring at the end of the first semester to District 7 he will be a Juvenile Advocate. He will be an educator for students on probation. He will be building a program with credit recover and wrap services to keep these students in school. It is a year round position for him. We are in the preliminary planning for the social studies position. It will be a temporary position through the end of the year.

We hired a new bookkeeper, Krystal Graham, she comes to us from Madrona. Madeleine is moving to the district office. She will be training Krystal the next couple of weeks.

Our foods class had a chopped competition. Our staff judged and the kids did an amazing job planning their own menu and preparing the food.

We held senior job interview, all but 5 students have complete their interview. We had many community volunteers come in and help with interviews and they were very impressed with the quality of the applications students completed and how they dressed up.

Friday morning we will have a staff breakfast and a Chinese gift exchange. We will have one lunch and Ryan is cooking lunch for our staff before we leave for the holiday.
