Vacant Teaching Positions:

- Grades 6-12 Physical Education Teacher. Interviews are scheduled for 8/3/17.
- Grades 9-12 Business Education. The position has been posted. We had a very small number of applicants due to this being an identified teacher shortage area in Wisconsin. Interviewing occurred. There was no accepted job offer. Other options were explored with Nicolet Technical College, CESA 9, distance learning, online coursework and other high schools. Some high school courses were reassigned to various departments where appropriate. Student enrolled in Business Ed courses that cannot be supported by other departments will be contacted to pursue one of the available options. We will investigate the availability of instructors for 2nd semester. However, plans are in place to accommodate students for the entire 17-18 school year if needed.
