- Ilitchiqpaktuat! Week 13: November Students have been growing their language skills through Ivalu. Our latest student on the leaderboard, Derek Amayun Solomon Coates, has 580 points.
- The ILT class, accompanied by Mrs. Justice, visited the senior center and sang Christmas carols for the seniors. The students introduced themselves in their Inupiat names and greeted each senior and staff member.
- The band, accompanied by Dr. Roseboro, played several selections for seniors. The event brought joy to many seniors present.
- Teachers have created weekly newsletters to parents informing them of upcoming and vital information for the school.
- The student council has established a dress code and anti-bullying posters throughout the building.
- Every Wednesday, the educators have developed lessons based on Inupiat values that focus on **Togetherness**, **Respect**, **Responsibility**, **A+ Attitude**, **Cooperation**, and **Kindness**.
- Students are rewarded every week with a nomination for Wolf of the Week. Criteria: Wolf of the Week: Criteria: Each grade level will pick one male and one female wolf of the week.
- The 6th grade team will pick one male and one female wolf.
- The 7th grade team will pick one male and one female wolf.
- The 8th grade team will pick one male and one female wolf.

Criteria for being wolf of the week!

- The wolf must not have office referrals, phone calls home, or failing grades.
- The wolf must arrive on time and be prepared for all classes.
- The wolf should complete all assignments on time, demonstrate leadership traits, and have a great attitude.
- The wolf must not disrupt the learning environment with negative behaviors, which include talking out of turn, moving in and out of the seat without permission, or non-participation.
- Finally, the wolf must demonstrate Togetherness, Respect and responsibility, A+ attitude, Cooperation, and Kindness daily.

Goal 1: Prioritize and implement intentional and purposeful partnerships.

- HMS hosts Wolf Dine daily during each lunch.
- HMS has teamed up with ASNA and Josh Stein for informative social-emotional lessons that touch on topics such as restorative practices.
- The principal, Mrs. Bellereide, sends a weekly email informing all parents of current and upcoming events (Bellereides Bytes).
- The 6th-grade teachers send a weekly newsletter to all parents.
- The 7th-grade teachers send a weekly newsletter to all parents.
- The 8th-grade teachers contact parents weekly through email and phone calls.
- HMS has partnered with Josh Stein and his team to provide social-emotional learning opportunities.
- The glimpse program is hosted bi-weekly by Ilisagvik faculty and staff to introduce various fields of study.
- HMS is hosting Eskimo Dancing each Thursday from 6:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m.

Culturally Responsive Instruction

Goal 2: All students perform at or above grade level

- All content teachers have a dedicated period to provide intervention and enrichment to help students perform on grade level and increase their reading and math proficiency.
- HMS has introduced social-emotional lessons throughout the week presented by the counselor, Dr. Bridges, to help students overcome challenges and develop positive behaviors.
- HMS has introduced **The Movement** Intervention. The movement intervention is a 15-minute weekly interval where students are given social-emotional learning as a form of intervention where students learn about teamwork, integrity, and leadership through movement.
- Mrs. Krecji, our reading interventionist, is working with students to improve their reading phonics and reading comprehension to prepare for state test testing.
