

Intergovernmental Agreement for School Districts Regional Office of Education #3



ROE 3 Alternative High Schools 2022-2023 School Year

The undersigned agree to the conditions stated below. It is understood that various changes can be made during any time of the school year with a signed agreement from all parties.

- 1. Our district will cooperate with ROE #3 alternative high school programs by (1) referring students who are 14-21 years of age and have dropped out of high school or are at risk of dropping out of high school, (2) providing ROE #3 programs with the student's transcripts and necessary records, and (3) providing the district high school's graduation requirements for the referred student.
- 2. Our district will accept academic credit earned at an ROE #3 alternative high school with the understanding that said earned credit meets acceptable standards of classroom time, state standards, and difficulty of course content.
- Our district will allow a student completing the district's graduation requirements in conjunction with an ROE 3 Alternative High School to graduate and receive the district's diploma. This position is dependent upon the student having been enrolled in and earning credit in our district's high school program at some time during his/her high school career. A student who has never enrolled in or earned credit from our district high school will not be granted a diploma from the district high school unless written permission is given by the district high school.
