Tractor Update- no scheduled date as of now to have tractor picked up, that the rest of the kits are in and will be put on. the rear 3<sup>rd</sup> function will be fixed at this time (had a small hydraulic leak when delivered this winter) witch was noted and will be fixed by Iron Hide of Grand Forks (no cost to school district) and the last loader attachment is in.

Boilers- boilers were shut down for the season on 5/2/2022, I am still working with O'Day Equipment out of Fargo on a fuel tank issue, O'Day installed the tank in fall of 1996 more than twenty-five years ago. Boilers will run 1 to 4 hours and then shut down on low oil pressure sensor. Both boilers do this, that is why it leads me to believe we have a fuel tank issue and not a boiler issue. Peterson Sheet Metal (PSM) our heating maintenance company also feels the same way, I had them come in to do a preventative maintenance and check boilers. I will keep the Board updated on this issue.

School- no major issues with the school, besides the normal wear and tear of everyday use on items and small fixes. Waiting for call back on the replacement for broken window in band room, had a call in late last summer to have a new window ordered and installed.
