Please state your proposal briefly and clearly. What do you want the board to know, discuss, or decide?

With the changes in interdistrict transfer laws, it is essential that we set a cap for incoming transfers for the school year 2018-19. The board will need to determine the number of slots open for out of district transfers for next school year. It is my recommendation that we open up a total of 86 slots; 30 elementary, 16 middle school and 40 high school.

Provide history/background information on your proposal.

Last year we opened up 91 slots and filled 73. Given our class sizes, existing enrollment numbers and the large number of remainder of the year requests, opening 86 slots seems appropriate.

List the advantages of your proposal:

This procedure follows the new interdistrict transfer laws and policies and allows us as much flexibility to meet student/building needs as possible.

List possible disadvantages of your proposal:

Potential impact on staffing ratios/class sizes. However, we will have certain grade levels at the elementary level in various buildings that will be closed to transfers to limit this impact.
