Dr. Wagner reviewed the case and determined cause of death was ASCVD with renal failure as a contributing cause. Toxicology was taken for contributing factors only.
04-0911-NP-2024	Alpena	Released to Funeral Home	81/F that was reported to have fallen at home and was admitted to SNF after incident. The female developed respiratory failure. Dr Wagner reviewed the case and determined that the fall with fracture was related to cause of death. Cause of death is complications of respiratory failure due to fracture from fall. The manner is accident.
04-0913-FW-2024	Alpena	Released to Funeral Home	71/M that was reported to have been found dead at home after a friend arrived. The male had a Hx of throat cancer and COPD. Dr Wagner determined that the cause of death was complications of throat cancer, the manner is natural.
04-0913-SL-2024	Alpena	Released to Funeral Home	66/M that was found dead at cottage by LE after a well-being check as requested from the family. The male had an extensive Hx of ethanol use and ASCVD. Dr Wagner reviewed the circumstances of the case and determined that the cause of death was complications of ASCVD with chronic ethanol use.
N24-0054	Alpena	Released to Autopsy Facility	53/F that was reported to have been found dead at home. It was reported that the female had a seizure Hx and had three seizures on Saturday. It was reported that she had fallen down during some of the seizures causing injury. A review of medications did not find any seizure medications currently being taken. Dr Wagner reviewed the case and ordered postmortem examination.
