Background Information:

- **AP (Advanced Placement)** examinations are administered each year in May and represent the culmination of college level work.
- Exams are scored on a scale of 1-5 with scores of 3, 4, and 5 receiving college credit from participating universities.
- An overview of May 2005 AP results was presented to the Board of Trustees on October 24, 2005.
