Type:	Code	Status:	Open

040524AK - The safety valve on the boiler is not mounted directly to the boiler. The safety valve must be mounted as close to the boiler as possible. If it is not installed in the correct position, the safety valve may not operate as intended. Correct the installation of the safety valve so that it is mounted in an upright position and as close to the boiler as possible. This installation shall meet all current codes. Code: NBIC Part 4, 2.2.10 b)
