

CURRENT POLICY

The Superintendent or designee is authorized to declare District materials, equipment, and supplies to be unnecessary and shall dispose of unnecessary materials, equipment, and supplies for fair market value. If the unnecessary property has no value, the Superintendent or designee may dispose of such property according to administrative discretion.

Items obtained as federal surplus shall be managed according to federal regulations.

ALTERNATE TASB VERSION: 7-24-2014

The Superintendent or designee is authorized to declare District materials, equipment, and supplies to be unnecessary.

The Board shall approve disposal of unnecessary property with a value greater than \$_____. The Superintendent or designee is authorized to dispose of all other unnecessary property for fair market value. If the unnecessary property has no value, the Superintendent or designee may dispose of such property according to administrative discretion.

Items obtained as federal surplus shall be managed according to federal regulations.
