- 1. We are qualified to attend. Our invitation is based on a qualifying video sent to Jamz National Cheerleading Competition. This video showcases our skill set and qualifying routine.

- 6. Yes, students will miss 2.5 days of school. Cheerleaders have historically maintained over a 3.25 cumulative GPA and will be required to maintain a good academic standard to qualify to join the trip. These student/athletes will be spending 3 nights away from home and family time, however we have strong parent support for this trip and many parents will be attending.
- 7. Currently we have enough budgeted to pay the cost of air travel, once we have district approval we will be investigating group discounts as well.
- 8. We plan on staying at The Orleans Hotel. This is the location of the competition and has group discounts for participants.
- 9. Our three coaches and our team Mom will be supervising and we have 2 high school staff members who have volunteered to chaperone if needed.
- 10. The Molalla High School cheer program has never qualified for such an event.
- 11. Parents have been notified that we are trying to go, and have been working along side us creating the plan and fundraising. Once we have approval, they will be notified we are attending for sure and once our travel arrangements have been secured we will post on our private team group and give written itinerary along will permission slips to parents.
