What Is E-Rate?

- E-Rate is a program administered by the FCC which connectivity, including internet helps schools afford their telecommunications
- E-Rate funds are generally used for four purposes:
- telecommunications/phone service
- internet connectionsinternal connections and
- internal connection maintenance

Where Did E-Rate Come From?

- Created as part of the 1996 reauthorization of the Telecommunications Act
- An already existing program was expanded to include funding to support connectivity in schools and libraries
- The funds come from telecommunications companies, who usually pass the fee along to consumers
- You can see the fee (Universal Services Fund) on your monthly phone bill

E-Rate? How Do Schools Benefit from

- telecommunications connectivity. The E-Rate program provides funding, in the form of a discount, that helps schools afford their
- E-Rate was critical in the massive expansion of Internet access to schools over the last decade
- As digital learning becomes the 'norm' in education, internet access and adequate bandwidth are a 'must-have', something E-Rate supports.
- Discounts are based on Free and Reduced Lunch counts

Note: Denton ISD traditionally receives an average of a 60% discount in Category 1 funding per year. For 2014, the discount is 62% for eligible services.

Moving Forward (2015 & Beyond)

- Starting with Year 2015 (Fiscal 2015-16), the e-rate program is undergoing significant changes.
- E-Rate is phasing out discounts for voice services. Phase out is 20% per year. So, DISD's discount in 2015 will be approximately 40%, 20% in 2016, and near zero in 2017. For 2014, voice services totaled \$ 330,300.72 with an erate discount of \$ 204,786.45.
- Discounts for Broadband Services (Internet Circuits, etc) will continue to be fully supported. For 2014, broadband services totaled \$ 45,499.92 with an e-rate discount of \$28,209.95. Category 2 services (network & wireless equipment) will
- be subject to a five year pre-discount budget of \$150 per student / campus. With an expected discount of 60%, this translates to about \$ 90 per student / campus.
