Summary of Major Changes

- Moved the “Student Information System” section to a more logical spot.
- Added clarification regarding retention and promotion to ensure all stakeholders are aware of our internal processes to move students on to the next grade level and/or to the next course in a sequence.
- Separated general academic probation from extracurricular academic probation
- Academic Probation
 - Separated Grades 6-8 and 9-12
 - Clarified Academic Eligibility criteria and Academic Check points for Extracurricular Activities
 - Added section for Considerations for IEP/504s
 - Added section for Appeal Process
- Updated late work policies to ensure consistency across classrooms, to give students more opportunities to earn higher grades if and when their assignments are late.
- Clarified missed work due to any absences is to be made up.
- Added language about the use of Artificial Intelligence as a replacement for students’ original ideas
- Revised attendance language to define “chronically tardy” and included tentative language to allow for case-by-case consideration of consequences.
