- Funding also provides 5 additional Head Start staff members:
  - Education Specialist
  - Parent Involvement Specialist
  - Office Clerk
  - Social Service/Eligibility, Recruitment, and Selection Specialist
  - Social Services Clerk



#### **Financial Audit Information**

#### Federal

- The last Head Start fiscal monitoring was in 2012 and their were no findings.
- Due to the new regulations and guidelines, Head Start program components and financial audit are now performed separately. During the 2016-2017 school year Head Start did not conduct any fiscal monitoring while they worked on these guidelines.

#### Local

- Denton ISD conducts an annual financial audit that includes review of all federal funding. The last one was completed in November of 2016 with no material findings.
- The audit for 2016-2017 is currently being conducted with a scheduled completion date of November 2017.
