Strategy Students Served Frequency Evidence of Impact

- Physical data tracking of students in the data room. All kids have a color coordinated card based on last year's STAAR performance as well as what programs they participate in (ex. 504, SPED, EB). Data meetings will be held in the room and teachers will physically move students based on performance on CBA giving a visual representation of if kids are moving forward or regressing.
- 9 week academic pep rallies based on grades, attendance, and discipline. Students will have to qualify to attend the events and they will receive rewards for their hard work.
- We will continue with the Zearn reward system put in place 5 lessons in a week equals 1 ticket for concession stand item (Thurs afternoons) Students will track their progress in lessons done in mindset classes and math teachers will use the information tracked to provide teacher table supports
- ELAR intervention will focus on STAAR writing with ELAR teachers providing feedback to students in their mindset classes. Students participated this week in an assessment that will determine what lessons the ELAR teachers push out to them. ELAR teachers will pull kids to teacher table for writing support based on the work done in mindset
