The board of trustees met with the community facility committee and school administration to narrow down the various facility possibilities that was discussed in the prior meeting, listed below:

## <u>SSHS</u>

Location:

- Current: West of school
- Current: South of school
- Current: ball diamonds
- East of town near airport
- West of Town El Toro
- West of Town ALCO
- North of TMS School

Configuration:

- 9-12 grades
- 7-12 grades with 7-8 wing

<u>TMS</u>

New gym Add wing Tear existing down gym Tear existing down annex If HS here, athletics to East

Configuration:

- K- 6
- 4 6
- 6 8



Add wing to South Add commons area Small group space The group was challenged to envision what configuration of school buildings would be needed in the district in the year 2045. The group first established the needs based criterion that we would evaluate the brain storming options:

- 1. Education
  - a. Technology & Infrastructure
  - b. Environment
- 2. Safety
- 3. Share Staff
- 4. Financial Savings
- 5. Maintainability
- 6. School Spirit & Social Settings

The group decided that in all options a gym at TMS was a priority. They also decided that for the new High School, it should be a closed campus for security reasons.

The group came up with a three (3) building option and a two (2) building option:

Three Building Option:

- $\blacktriangleright$  New High School housing grades 7<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> which would include a new gym
- Existing TMS building housing grades  $4^{th} 6^{th}$  with the addition of a new gym
- > Existing Thirkill building housing grades Kindergarten  $-3^{rd}$  grade

## Two Building Options:

- New High School housing grades  $7^{\text{th}} 12^{\text{th}}$  which would include a new gym
- Existing TMS building housing grades Kindergarten  $-6^{th}$  with the addition of new classrooms and a new gym.

OR

- Existing TMS building housing grades  $7^{th} 12^{th}$  with the addition of new classrooms and new gym.
- Existing Thirkill building housing grades Kindergarten  $-6^{th}$  with the addition of new classroom and gym

The location was discussed for the new high school between using the existing property at the current high school or purchasing property either on the West or on the East side of town. It was decided that using the existing property of the high school would be best.

Clerk Balls will contact Garett with Plan One Architect to start sketches and pricing on these options. Then public meetings will be held, as well as a phone survey conducted, to help determine which option would be best. It was discussed being ready for the public to vote on the best option by November 3<sup>rd</sup>.
