**A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE UNITED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT'S  
BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND THE CITY OF LAREDO CITY COUNCIL TO SUPPORT  
A NATATORIUM**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Laredo, Texas is a Home Rule Municipal Corporation formed pursuant to Tex. Loc. Gov't Code § 9.001, et. seq and is governed by its City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the United Independent School District is a political subdivision of the State of Texas and is governed by its Board of Trustees; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Laredo's Home Rule Charter authorizes the City to cooperate with governmental entities such as the United Independent School District in the provision of services to the citizens and residents of the City of Laredo; and

**WHEREAS**, the Laredo City Council and the Board of Trustees of the United Independent School District are committed to improving the quality of life for the residents of the United Independent School District and all Laredo residents; and

**WHEREAS**, improving the quality of life requires cities and school districts to develop visions and goals to achieve such purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Laredo and the United Independent School District both desire to improve the quality of life of Laredo and United Independent School District residents by entering into a joint cooperative venture for the construction of a Natatorium for the enjoyment by the residents of the United Independent School District and the citizens of Laredo; and

**WHEREAS**, the costs of the construction of the said Natatorium will be borne by the United Independent School District and the City of Laredo as determined by the budgets of each governmental entity; and

**WHEREAS**, the United Independent School District and the City of Laredo are authorized to enter into interlocal agreements pursuant to the provisions of the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Texas Government Code, as amended, Section 791.001 et seq. (the "Act"); and

**WHEREAS**, the United Independent School District and City of Laredo will enter into such an agreement to determine the rights, responsibilities, and duties of each party concerning the construction and operation of the Natatorium at a near future meeting;

**NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE UNITED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT DO HEREBY RESOVLE AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The recitals set forth above are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and Board of Trustees and made part of this Resolution for all purposes.
- Section 2. If any portion of this Resolution is declared invalid, such declaration shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Resolution.
- Section 3. The Resolution shall be effective immediately upon approval.
