#### PROPOSAL details:

1. What is something that you would like very much to do for or with your students but you cannot currently afford to do it?

I would love to provide a hands on learning experience of life cycles (plants, flowers,) for my 21 first grade students.

2. In 200 words or less, describe this project, listing the estimated costs of the items of the planned project totaling up to \$600.

With this grant I will purchase flower beds for my classroom. This would allow for students to get a hands on experience with studying flower/plant life cycles. This will help show different stages and steps in the process of the flower/plant life. We will set the flower beds up as a class. We will research what kind of plants we can grow (depending on the season), the type of soil we should use (will it matter). We will also research how to take care of the flowers, what do to, and how to do it. We will go through each stage (seed, stem, and flower) together as a class.

- 1. Garden raised bed, 2 beds (Home depot \$195)
- 2. Gardening soil, 8 bags (Home depot \$85)
- 3. Seeds and Flowers (Home Depot \$65)
- 4. Shake and feed flower food/ fertilizer (\$50)
- Decorations/gloves/watering can (\$48)
- Garden gate (\$115) 6.
- 7. Flower trellis (\$36)
