World language teachers, Gina Nolan and Deanna Bach, would like to request permission to organize a spring break 2016 trip to Costa Rica. The purpose of the trip is to provide an educational and cultural experience for our students that will reinforce and enhance their language abilities and cultural appreciation. It will provide students with the unique opportunity to experience and interact with people from Costa Rica. Tentative itinerary and trip details are attached:

1. Trip Dates:

Spring Break 2016 (Saturday - Sunday; 9-day/8-night)

2. Number of Students:

Approximately 15-20

3. Transportation:

International Air Carrier (will book through local travel agent) / Intercultura Language School transportation

4. Cost of Trip:

Approximately \$2000 - \$2300

5. Adult Chaperones

6. Goals:

- a. To provide students with the opportunity for complete immersion into the Spanish language and culture.
- b. To reinforce and enhance student language comprehension and conversation skills.
- c. To provide students the opportunity to experience home-life with a Costa Rican family and further enrich their understanding of Latin American customs and culture.
- d. To further create a desire in students to be lifelong learners of language and culture.

Saturday - Sunday Tentative Itinerary:

During the week: Attend morning Spanish language classes; participate in cultural activities such as Latin dance or cooking classes in the afternoon; participate in one or two half-day excursions after classes

Saturday: Arrive in Heredia, Costa Rica, and get settled with home stay families

Sunday: Full-day excursion/ Cataratas (waterfalls)

Monday: Class 8-12 / Tour of Heredia town center

Tuesday: Class 8-12 / Trip to San José to visit National Museum and National Theater

Wednesday: Class 8-12 / Café Britt Coffee Tour

Thursday: Class 8-12 / Cultural activity (Dancing, Cooking, etc)

Friday: Class 8-12 / Volunteering / Nice dinner in Heredia

Saturday: Full-day excursion/ Barva Adventure Canopy Tour with zip line

Sunday: Return to Chicago

Price includes:

- 1. Week of small-group language classes at Intercultura (no more than 6 students per class)
- 2. 8-night home stay with a Costa Rican family (includes 3 meals per day)
- 3. All excursions and cultural activities
- 4. Roundtrip airfare from Chicago to San Jose, Costa Rica
