Testing & Accountability

State Interim testing is open for Mathematics testing for grade 3 through Algebra I EOC. BISD campuses will begin their administrations the second week of November. In addition to online testing, campuses may also administer State released STAAR/EOC assessments in ELAR, History, and Science. Starting November 22nd, online Interim Assessments for ELAR, Science, and History will be open to all qualifying grade levels.

At-Risk/McKinney-Vento

Bandera High School students who qualify for homeless services, are eligible for additional funding on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Bandera High School Counselors are currently assisting BHS students in this process. Upon request, BISD will provide each student with a letter of verification to accompany the student's FAFSA submission to open up these additional opportunities for the student.

Federal Programs

Bandera ISD submitted the application for the 2019-20 Title I, Part A, Improving Basic Programs. If awarded, the grant will provide supplemental resources to BISD to help schools with high concentrations of students from low-income families provide high quality education, which will enable all children to meet the federal student performance standards. Title I, Part A, supports schools in implementing either a schoolwide program or a targeted assistance program. The Title I, 1003 - School Improvement Grant will be used to support the designated schools with their school improvement efforts and the implementation and/or in support of their targeted improvement plan.
