# DISD Designation of the Location for Comprehensive High School No. 4

#### **SUMMARY:**

This item requests approval of the 380 corridor as the location for Comprehensive High School No. 4

#### **BOARD GOAL:**

- Work consistently with the community in planning and facility development
- Review and adjust policies and procedures effectively to address the challenges of rapid growth and changing demographic characteristics while maintaining and enhancing our strong sense of community
- Create and continuously modify strategies to mitigate increasing stresses on our children, our schools, and our community

#### PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

• There has been no previous board action on this agenda item.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

• The 2007 bond package included funds for planning comprehensive high school no. 4. In order to begin that planning the Board of Trustees conducted a series of workshop session centered on facility planning.

The July planning sessions included but were not limited to discussion of the following topics:

- Reviewed community comments from May 2008 High School Attendance Boundary Adjustment
- Discussed Middle School/Elementary School design information inclusive of future space for Pre-K.
- Discussed Considerations as DISD approaches .50 cent Interest and Sinking tax rate
- Discussed Capping of Permanent School Fund
- Upon review of the demographic data and growth projections DISD staff provided by DISD staff
- 50 cent I and S tax rate
  - Growth no longer pays for growth due to increase in construction cost and a decrease in value growth.
  - Increase in construction costs will accelerate the I and S tax rate.
  - HS design/capacity may need to alter :
  - for the district to be more efficient with bond dollars
  - Accommodate HS students on the 380 corridor, and southern growth
  - Accommodate population shifts within the district
  - Create Learning communities inclusive of two middle schools for each high school

The August planning sessions included but were not limited to discussion of the following topics:

- Discussed HS enrollments with current students attending DISD schools.
- Discussed HS enrollments with a 4% growth rate
- Reviewed the high growth areas of the south and the 380 corridor.
- Provided demographic data stating the need for high school relief in the Fall of 2012

# **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:**

- Items for future discussion:
  - Discuss facility planning and high school capacity issues with district architects.
  - Involve the phasing of HS no. 4
  - Discuss the potential for expansion at current comprehensive high school campuses
  - Impact on student learning environment.

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

• Discuss debt capacity as it relates to growth and tax rate, Bill Gumbert will be in attendance at the October 7, 2008.

### BENEFIT OF ACTION:

• Passage will allow the district ample time to plan and study for future high school capacity requirements.
