SUBJECT: 2007 STATE ACCOUNTABILITY RATINGS AND

ANTICIPATED ADEQUATE YEARLY PROGRESS RATINGS

BOARD GOAL: All students will achieve educational excellence.

FISCAL NOTE: No Financial Impact

- State accountability ratings for 2007 were received from TEA (Texas Education Agency) on August 1, 2007.
- Preliminary TAKS (Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills) and SDAA II (State Developed Alternative Assessment) data was reviewed at the July 16 board meeting.
- Grade levels included for accountability are summed across all grades tested (3 11).
- "Snapshot" students are disaggregated and evaluated to determine state accountability ratings.
- Additional factor included in middle and high school calculations:
 - Completion Rate (Graduating Class of 2006): The percent of students who first attended ninth grade in the 2002-2003 school year who completed or who are continuing their education four years later.
 - o Annual Dropout Rate (Gr. 7-8): Data reflects 2005-2006 dropout rate
- Eighth grade Science results not included in determining 2007 ratings.
- State Developed Alternative Assessment II (SDAA II) administered for the last time in 06-07 and results were evaluated to determine campus and district ratings.
- KISD has nine Exemplary campuses, fourteen Recognized campuses, and eight Acceptable campuses.
- KISD has received an Acceptable rating for 2006-07.
- Preliminary unmasked Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) data was released to districts on August 8, 2007.
 - AYP ratings will be released by Texas Education Agency on August 15, 2007.
