BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:

All-Tex of Richmond submitted a price of \$52,530.00 to complete all networking and audio/visual cabling and outlets for the addition and renovation project for the Johnson Health Occupations Center. All-Tex has always done first rate work for the college and uses a TIPS/TAPS Cooperative to price their services. As authorized in the Texas Government Code, Title 7, Chapter 791, and again under section 271.102 of the Local Government Code, districts may utilize the contracts from purchasing cooperatives in order to provide the best value to the taxpayers of the District. Use of these cooperative contracts satisfy State bid law requirements.
