Statement of Services to be Performed

Develop and deliver virtual or face-to-face professional learning experiences for educators and administrators in four magnet schools, as well as provide differentiated, sustained technical assistance to support magnet campus needs. Professional learning or technical assistance will primarily focus on:

Introducing, modeling, exploring, and applying the elements of Student-Focused Coaching (i.e., co-authored by Drs. Daryl Michel and Jan Hasbrouck) and relating to magnet-related themes (e.g., Unit Design, SRSD); providing magnet leadership team coaching support.	10
Developing magnet, evidence-based themed units (i.e., essential questions, critical standards, desired results, products/projects, sample lessons and activities).	25
Collaborating with Self-Regulated Strategy Development (SRSD) staff and incorporating writing components into magnet unit learning experiences and instruction.	6
Collaborating with magnet coordinators to design units in Canvas to meet grant deadlines and deliverables (see Page 3 of this agreement).	4
Deciding, planning, and creating tools or resources to sustain Unit Design practices.	15

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Contract Amount and Deliverables

This agreement includes up to **60** days of virtual or face-to-face professional learning development and delivery and/or differentiated, sustained technical assistance to support magnet campus needs. Total amount of this Contract shall not exceed **\$120,000**.

Payment of Services

Receiving Party will remit payment(s) to Performing Party for services satisfactorily performed under this Contract in accordance with the Texas Prompt Payment Act, Chapter 2251, Texas Government Code **within thirty (30) days** after the receipt of invoice from Performing Party. Payments made under this Contract will (1) fairly compensate Performing Party for the services performed under this Contract, and (2) be made from current revenues available to Receiving Party.

Term of the Agreement

The term of this agreement is November 1, 2020, or date fully executed by both parties, and terminates on September 30, 2021.
