Bilingual Education Requirements

CT State Statute: Sec. 10-17f.

Duties of boards of education regarding bilingual education programs.

(b) Whenever it is ascertained that there are in any public school within a local or regional school district twenty or more eligible students classified as dominant in any one language other than English, the board of education of such district shall provide a program of bilingual education for such eligible students for the school year next following.

Our Students (24-25)

- 97 students, K-12 English Language / Multilingual Learners
- 10 languages (Spanish, Portuguese most prevalent)
- 43 Spanish-dominant language learners at NFES (eligible for bilingual services)
- Currently, 1.2 FTE dedicated to EL services K-12
