The District will make an effort to identify talented and gifted students from special populations such as:

- 1. Ethnic/Cultural/Racial Minorities;
- 2. Economically disadvantaged;
- 3. Students learning English as a second language;
- 4. Underachieving gifted;
- 5. Students with disabilities.

Careful selection of appropriate measures and a collection of behavioral or learning characteristics shall be used.

District staff have established an appeals process for parents to utilize if they are dissatisfied with the identification process of their student for the district program for talented and gifted students and wish to request reconsideration.
