WHAT:

A district monthly digital citizenship focus will be established (elementary, middle school, high school)

WHEN:

Students will be instructed on digital citizenship during advisory classes at the secondary level. At the elementary level, students will be instructed by their classroom teachers, as well as the computer teacher.

Professional Development:

Staff will receive professional development monthly through the following methods;

- Staff Meeting (monthly)
- Newsletter
 - Age appropriate resources will be provided on the first day of the month by district personnel (elementary, middle school).
 - High school will receive an email with bullet points of highlights of the monthly topic for teachers. The email will also include one resource for teachers. Josh Aston will be responsible for the email.
- All staff will receive an hour training in August
