  - NWF, CLS (phonics) last year: 41%/this year 59%
  - Reading Intervention targeting: PA

- b. First grade: Priority Focus: Phonics
  - NWF, CLS: 28% to 40% Core
  - Reading Intervention targeting: PA/Phonics
- c. Second grade: Priority Focus: Phonics
  - DORF Accuracy: 46% to 51% Core
  - Reading Intervention Targeting: PA/Phonics
- d. **Third grade**: Priority Focus: Phonics

    - o Fridays 9:30-11:30am (*Tawnya Campbell/Chelsea Bruner facilitate this group*)
    - o Average 9-12 families: 12-15 caregivers (mothers, fathers, grandmother/father, and babysitter) with 10-13 children.
    - o School closure- older siblings attended
  - b. Kindergarten Launch
    - o March Thursday March 2<sup>nd</sup>
    - o Flyer/registration for Kinder Bound after school Class
    - o Lunch box-take away for pre-kinders
    - o Online registration (District-wide)
  - Kinder Bound after school classes

- o Kindergarten readiness program
- o 10 week long comprehensive program
- o Engages pre-kindergarteners in a variety of activities that target:
  - pre-literacy skills, math readiness, language and communication skills, fine and gross motor skills, and social and emotional development.
- o Facilitators: T. Campbell, E. Lundberg, C. Bruner
- o Begins Monday March 6
- o Mon/Wed after school: 3:15-4:45pm
- o Depending on future funding: Return for the summer academy 2 weeks in August, Mon-Thur: 4 hours per/day
- Partnering with Family Connections: Parenting class facilitated by Pam White of Head Start
  - o Kick off last week: Community resources offered a variety of take-aways, dinner was served,
  - o 14 families attended
  - o Classes running for 7 weeks
  - o Provide the family with dinner, daycare, takeaways
