Agenda Item: Consider for Approval of Award for Fencing RFP 2425-006

Summary:

A solicitation for proposals was issued and five (5) responses were received. After the evaluation of the submitted proposals, it is recommended to award this project to the vendor that provides the best value to the District: Anderson Fencing and Custom Welding for a cost not to exceed the following:

- Press Point/Flat Top Fencing \$36.75 linear foot
- Pass Thru Gate with Panic Bar \$1,050.00 each
- Egress Gate \$4,462.50 each
- Double Vehicle Gate \$3,675.00 each

This vendor also offered a 10% discount for any additional items that may be needed at time of installation.

Based on estimated linear footage and needed gates, the estimated cost of this project should not exceed \$400,000. The Safety and Security team will work closely with Facility Services to oversee the scheduling of the installation of this project to provide the least amount of interference with campus activities

This RFP adhered to all requirements for expenditures under Federal Education Department General Administrative Regulations (EDGAR).
