Pat Cheek Middle School Technology Purchase

March 28, 2023

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quotes from Dell in the amount of \$802,328.06 for Pat Cheek Middle School end-user technology equipment.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management – Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The Board called for the 2018 bond election with the recommendation of the Bond Committee. On May 5, 2018, the bond was approved by the voters of Denton ISD.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Technology Division requested technology end-user equipment quotes. The quotes were reviewed by the Technology Division to ensure items quoted maintained the current District technology standards along with item pricing. The quotes from Dell total \$802,328.06.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

The new equipment will provide student and staff desktop computers with monitors, laptops, Chromebooks, and Fuyf Tower for Pat Cheek Middle School. This technology equipment and installation will be purchased through a Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperative (DIR). This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District’s CH (local) policy

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne through the 2018 bond authorization.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to order the technology equipment and arrange for installation in time to be ready for the 2023-2024 school year.

It is recommended that the quotes from Dell in the amount of \$802,328.06 for Pat Cheek Middle School end-user technology equipment be approved.
