SUBJECT: Proposed Additions to Board Policy 4370 – Graduation Requirements (2nd Reading)

On May 5, 2021, amendments to Policy 4370 - Graduation Requirements were presented to the board for a first reading. Since the May meeting, there has been no additional input concerning the proposed additions of criteria for the Career Development Credential option.

This addition is proposed to be in compliance with amendments made by the Utah State Board of Education to Utah State Board of Education Administrative Rule R277-705, Secondary School Completion and Diplomas. The revised rule now allows a school district to award a Career Development Credential to a student receiving services or support through an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or 504, if the student meets the criteria outlined in the rule.
