As of September 5, 2025, we have 435 students currently enrolled at McNary.

Last year there were 641 students enrolled at this time.

Start of School: We're off to a great start!

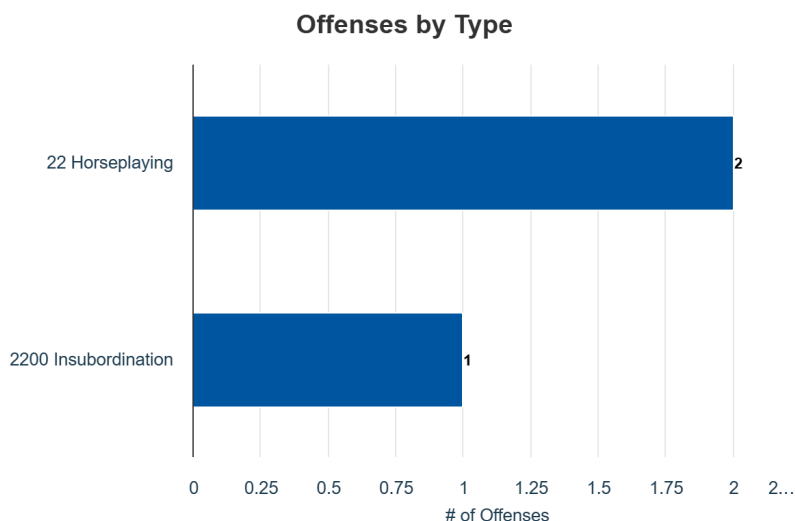
