BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010 (HHFKA) requires all local educational agencies participating in federal Child Nutrition programs to establish and implement, for all schools under its jurisdiction, local school wellness policies that meet minimum standards designed to promote sound nutrition, student health, reduce childhood obesity, and provide transparency to the public on the school nutrition environment. Part of the mission of the District is to improve the health of the entire community by teaching students and families ways to establish and maintain life-long healthy eating and physical activity habits. The mission shall be accomplished through nutrition education, physical education and activity, and food served in schools. The District shall develop nutritional guidelines and wellness goals in consultation with the local SHAC (school health advisory committee) and with involvement from representatives of the student body, school food service, school administration, the Board, parents, and the public. [See BDF and EHAA] The District shall ensure that nutritional guidelines for reimbursable school meals shall be at least as restrictive as federal regulations and guidance and that all foods available on each campus are in accordance with the Texas Public School Nutrition Policy. [See CO]
