Facilities Committee

The Facilities Committee did not meet this month. The next meeting is December 4 at 6:00 PM in the High School Library.

Building Updates

PES. The window film for the classrooms has been installed and it looks very nice. The 3M shatterproof film has also been completed with the exception of the Office. This will be finished on the 16th of November. Reliable has started our fall service of the HVAC. This service falls under our service agreement with them, which will be done twice a year. This will also take place at the Jr. High and High School.

The boiler that had the relief valve pop off has been fixed. Reliable told me that the high and low pressure valves in the expansion take were reversed.

HS. There is not much to report on the high school other than there have been a few issues with some of the new door hardware. I have contacted the Company that installed them and they will be here on the 20^{th} of November to fix them.

JH. We have installed a new walk in freezer behind the cafeteria. We had to run electric to it and pour a concrete pad. It is up and running.

Sale of Property

We will be Auctioning off the excess property at Washington and Lincoln Schools. This will consist of desks, chairs, kitchen equipment and other small items. We will need a Resolution approved for the sale of these items.

Transportation

We had a new lift bus that was to be here a month ago and during delivery it was wrecked. Mid West Transit has sold our bus and will be bringing us a loaner until they get our new one built.
