TITLE: Recognition of Trevor Dickerson, CDO student and DECA state officer

BACKGROUND:

Trevor Dickerson, a student at CDO High School, has been selected as a State Representative for Arizona's chapter of DECA, an association of marketing students. The DECA organization is designed to prepare young emerging leaders and entrepreneurs within the areas of management, marketing, finance and hospitality.

To become a state representative, which can only happen while a student is in his or her senior year, a student participates in a rigorous process consisting of three interviews over the course of a single day. The interviews are with the DECA state leaders, alumni and current state officers.

There are eight state officers (president, vice president, secretary, and five representatives). The officers oversee the student part of the organization which has 6,600 members and holds six conferences a year.

Trevor is also planning to run for a National DECA Office in the spring. He wants to run for the Western Region Vice President position.
