

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION DIRECTING THE  
SCHOOL TREASURER TO PARTIALLY ABATE AND  
PERMANENTLY TRANSFER MONIES FROM THE TRANSPORTATION FUND TO THE  
OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE FUND AND THE EDUCATION FUND**

WHEREAS, the Transportation Fund of Dunlap CUSD #323, Peoria County, Illinois (the "School District"), has heretofore created and established a Transportation Fund in and for the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined and does hereby determine that it is necessary and in the best interests of the District that the part of the Transportation Fund be abated and transferred to the Operations and Maintenance Fund and Education Fund; and

WHEREAS, Sections 17-2A of the School Code provide that the Board of Education has the power to partially abate and permanently transfer a portion of the fund balance between the Educational Fund, Operations and Maintenance (O&M) Fund, Transportation Fund, and Tort Immunity Fund.; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the School District that the Board of Education direct the School Treasurer to partially abate and permanently transfer a portion of the fund balance in the Transportation Fund to the Operations and Maintenance Fund and Education Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of Dunlap CUSD #323, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the Board of Education hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Resolution are full, true, and correct and does hereby incorporate them into this Resolution by reference.

Section 2. The Transportation Fund of the District shall be abated as of the date hereof by the amount (the "Abatement Amount") of \$1,570,000 to the Operation and Maintenance Fund and \$630,000 to the Education Fund.

Section 3. The School Treasurer of the District is hereby authorized and directed to forthwith permanently transfer the Abatement Amount to the Operations and Maintenance Fund and the Education Fund of the District, this fund being herein found by the Board as being the fund of the District most in need of the moneys being so transferred.

Section 4. That all other resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately and forthwith upon its passage.
