☒ **Goal 1\*:** The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 49% to 60% by June 2024, 65% for 2024-2025, 70% for 2025-2026, 75% for 2026-2027, 80% for 2027-2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**

☒ **Goal 2\*:** Increased overall student performance in mathematics to 85% Meets Standard by 2028. The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase from 53% to 65% by June 2024, 70% for 2024-2025, 75% for 2025-2026, 80% for 2026-2027, 85% for 2027-2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**

☒ **Goal 3\*:** The percentage of graduates that meet the criteria for CCMR will increase from 72% to 88% by August 2024 and increase to 95% by 2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**

As part of our ongoing efforts to increase the number of students reaching *Meets* and *Masters* levels on state assessments, Navarro ISD will continue to closely monitor state accountability data to ensure we are on track to meet our academic goals. These continuous data reviews allow us to make informed adjustments to curriculum and instructional practices as needed.

We recognize that overall academic performance is shaped by a range of factors—including graduation rates, the performance of special population groups, and College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) indicators.

Navarro ISD remains committed to academic excellence and equitable outcomes for all students. The 2025 accountability data affirms much of the progress we’ve made, while also identifying key areas for targeted improvement. As more data becomes available, we will keep the Board informed and respond with strategic actions designed to support the success of every learner.
