- SUBJECT: Consideration and possible approval of a partnership between the Pasadena Independent School District and the City of Houston through its Houston Health Department for implementation of the See to Succeed Program.
- BACKGROUND: Houston Health Department seeks to provide no-cost vision exams and eyewear to students ages 6-18 with unresolved vision issues to enhance the students' capacity to learn. Comprehensive vision exams that include testing for disease, color blindness, depth perception and eye muscle balance testing will be performed by qualified city personnel and its partners.

Students with unresolved vision issues will be transported to a mutually agreed upon site for this comprehensive exam. Parental consent for vision services and transportation will be required prior to student participation.
