Strategies

- Provide daily reading instruction using at least one of the seven comprehension keys.
- Utilize reading block for whole group/small group instruction.
- Pose/Post open ended questions during reading lessons daily.
- Provide weekly close reading lessons.
- Provide weekly opportunities for students to produce written responses to problem solving questions using a rubric for evaluation.
- Provide a daily math block whole/small group.
- Provide daily math opportunities for students to engage in at least one of the following: modeling problem solving strategies; re-teaching and practice; providing manipulatives; and visual representation.
- Utilize peer grouping with math problem solving activities weekly.
