Emergency Generator

We are moving forward on the emergency generator project at the 906 Admin. building and the Van Buren building .Studio G.C. will have 50% of the specs complete by the end of this week (2/8/13). The bids will go out on 2/22/13 due back on 3/12/13. Letter of recommendation and bids for Board Packet will be ready 3/15/13 with the actual awarding of contract to take place at the 3/21/13 board meeting.

Garfield School Gym Floor

The Garfield School gym floor is complete and in use. However we along with the expert opinions provided to us by an engineer Studio G.C. sent in and Atomatic Mechanical has discovered a humidity problem coming from the crawl space affecting the gym floor. We need an additional exhaust fan installed for ventilation within the crawl space and to install a new humidity control; and freeze stat protection.

I am recommending that we move forward on this project having Atomatic Mechanical do the work at a cost of \$12,815.00 which is covered under our current contract with them ,not costing the district beyond the \$53,088 we are already required to pay. Currently we have placed two extra fans in the gym and a fan in the crawl space giving us a temporary relief to this problem.
