Latest family survey was part of the district strategic planning process during the 2024 – 2025 school year. 171 people responded to the survey with a good representation of parents across all 4 buildings including preschool

programming. Majority felt their child or children were happy at school, safe at school, academically challenged at school, staff are supportive, school is clean, school and teachers do a good job communicating with families, and their culture is represented. Part of the survey had an open ended question for concerns and as much as many feel the above is well, some feel differently. Staffing/teacher support, communication/transparency, and transportation were areas that came up that could need improvement. Overall the community gave high marks to the job the district is doing.
