TOPIC: Approval of Districtwide Phone System Update

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase and installation of a Districtwide Phone System Update by Sentinel Technologies, Livonia, Michigan, in the amount of is \$404,261.13.

RATIONALE:

The current hardware (servers) is approximately seven years old and was replaced as part of the 2013 Bond project. Due to the announced end of hardware support and a change from perpetual to annual licensing, the proposed purchase will replace and update our current Cisco phone system. Pricing comes from the National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO), which fulfills the Board's bidding obligation. This purchase will include software, hardware, professional services, and a five-year maintenance plan. There will be a first-year cost in the amount of \$138,764.23 and then an additional \$66,374.23 paid over the following 4 years.
